General Information:

Amherst Public Library is a school district library, controlled and managed by a seven member Board of Trustees. **By law, trustees serve for a term of seven years and without compensation.** Applications are reviewed by both Amherst Public Library Board of Trustees and the Amherst School's Board of Education, with the Board of Education making the final selection, following a recommendation from the library Board.

Responsibilities of library trustees are set forward in the Ohio Revised Code. Primarily, trustees are responsible for setting library policy, for setting the library's budget, and for hiring the Fiscal Officer and Library Administrator to oversee library operations.
